Said notice shall also be given to all other representatives of Texas ARM University and Vendor otherwise entitled to notice under the parties contact. Compliance by Vendor with subchapter B is a condition precedent to the filling of a contested case processing under Chapter 2260, subchapter C of the Texas Government Code.

 The contested case process provised in Chapter 2260, subchapter C, of the Texas Government Code is Vendor's sole and exclusive process for seeking a remedy for any and all alteged breaches of contract by Texas ARM University if the parties are unable to resolve their disputes under subparagraph (A) of this paragraph.

 Compliance with the contested case process, provided in subchapter C is a condition precedent to seeking consent to sue from the Legislature under Ch. 107 of the Colf Practices and Remedes Code. Neither the execution of this contract by Texas ARM University nor any conduct of any representative of Texas ARM University hereafter shall be considered a waiver of severeign immunity to suit. Vendor's claim for breach of this contract that the parties cannot resolve in
- - waiver of sovereign immunity to suit.

 (1) The submission, processing, and resolution of Vendor's claim is governed by the published rules as adopted by the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas pursuant to Chapter 2260 as

 - Atomey General of the State of Texas pursuant to Chapite 2266 a currently effective, hereafter enacted or subsequently amended Nether the occurrence of an event nor the pendency of a claim constitutes grounds for the suspension of the performance by Vendor. In whole or in part.

 The designated individual responsible on behalf of Texas A&M University for examining any claim or counterclaim and conducting any negotiations related thereto, as required under 2260.052 of the Texas Government Code shall be Philips A. Ray, Assistant Vee President of Strategic Sourcing and Contract Administration.
