### ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION

The dispute resolution process provided for in Chapter 2260 of the Texas Government Code shall be used, as further described herein, by Texas A&M. University, and the Vendor to attempt to resolve any claim for breach of contract made by Vendor.

- le by Vendor: Vendor's claim for breach of this contract that the parties cannot resolve in the ordinary course of business shall be submitted to the negotiation process provided in Chapter 2250, subchapter B, of the Texas Government Code. To initiate the process, Vendor shall submit written notice, as required by suchapter B, of the Texas Government Code. To initiate the process, Vendor shall submit written notice, as required by subchapter B, to Philip A, Ray, Assistant Vice President of Strategic Sourcing and Contract Administration. Said notice shall also be given to all other representatives of Texas, ARM University and Vendor otherwise entitled to notice under the parties' contract. Compliance by Vendor' with subchapter B is a condition precedent to the filing of a contested case proceeding under Chapter 2260, subchapter C, of the Texas Government Code.

  The contested case process provided in Chapter 2260, subchapter C, of the Texas Government Code is Vendor's sole and exclusive process for seeking a remedy for any and all alleged breaches of contract by Texas A&M University if the parties are unable to resolve their disputes under subparagraph (A) of this paragraph.

  Compliance with the contested case process provided in subchapter C is a condition precedent to seeking consent to sue from the Legislature under Ch. 107 of the Coli Practices and Remedes Code. Neither the execution of this contract by Texas A&M University nor any conduct of any representative of Texas A&M University thereafter shall be considered a wave of suveregor immunity to suff. Vendor's claim for breach of this contract that the parties cannot resolve in
- - resentative of Texas A&M University thereafter shall be considered a were of sovereign immunity to suit.

    The submission, processing, and resolution of Venoor's claim is governed by the published rules as adopted by the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas pursuant to Chapter 2260 as currently effective, hereafter enacted or subsequently amenoed. Neither the occurrence of an event nor the pendency of a claim constitutes grounds for the suspension of the performance by Vendor, in whole or in part.
