 (c) A bid or an application for a contract, grant, or loan paid from state funds must include the name and social security number of the individual or sole propriets and each partner, shareholder, or owner with an ownership interest of at least 25 percent of the business entity submitting the bid or application.
- (d) A contract, bid, or application subject to the requirements of this section A comination to the diphyration solyset of the vendor or applicant certifies that Tunor Section 23.1006, Family Code, the vendor or applicant certifies that the individuo or business entity named in this contract, bid, or application is not ineligible to receive the specified grant, loan, or payment and acknowledge that this contract may be terminated and payment may be

 It is state agency determines that an individual or business entity holding a state contract is meligible to receive payment under Subsection (a), the contract may be terminated.

 This section does not create a cause of action to contest a bid or award of a state grant, loan, or contract. The Tifle IV-D agency and other affected agencies are encouraged to develop a system by which the Tifle IV-D agency may identify a business entity that is ineligible to receive a state payment under Subsection (a) and to ensure that a state payment to the entity is not made. This system should be implemented using existing funds and only if the Tifle IV-D agency, comptroller, and other affected agencies determine that it will be cost-effective. letermine that it will be cost-effective
