The footprint of the seat cover tarps shall cover the entire Level 4 West side sections AC1-AC4, LC5-LC8, AC9-AC12 and section ZC14-ZC16 to prevent the vinyl padded seat cushions from weathering.

The successful vendor shall come on-site and perform measurements of stadium sections outlined in the project within ten (10) business days of bid award. Project Completion shall be no later than May 13, 2022.

Installation shall be performed using bungee straps, anchor clips and/or carabiners.

Tarp Specifications:

- Grey in color
- 14 oz vinyl coated polyester mesh tarp armor material for long lasting durability
- Reinforced hems and brass grommets spaced 18" apart on all borders of tarp
- Air vents in tarps
- 75% shade cover
- Poly cord threaded through all grommets on all borders for increased durability on tarps
